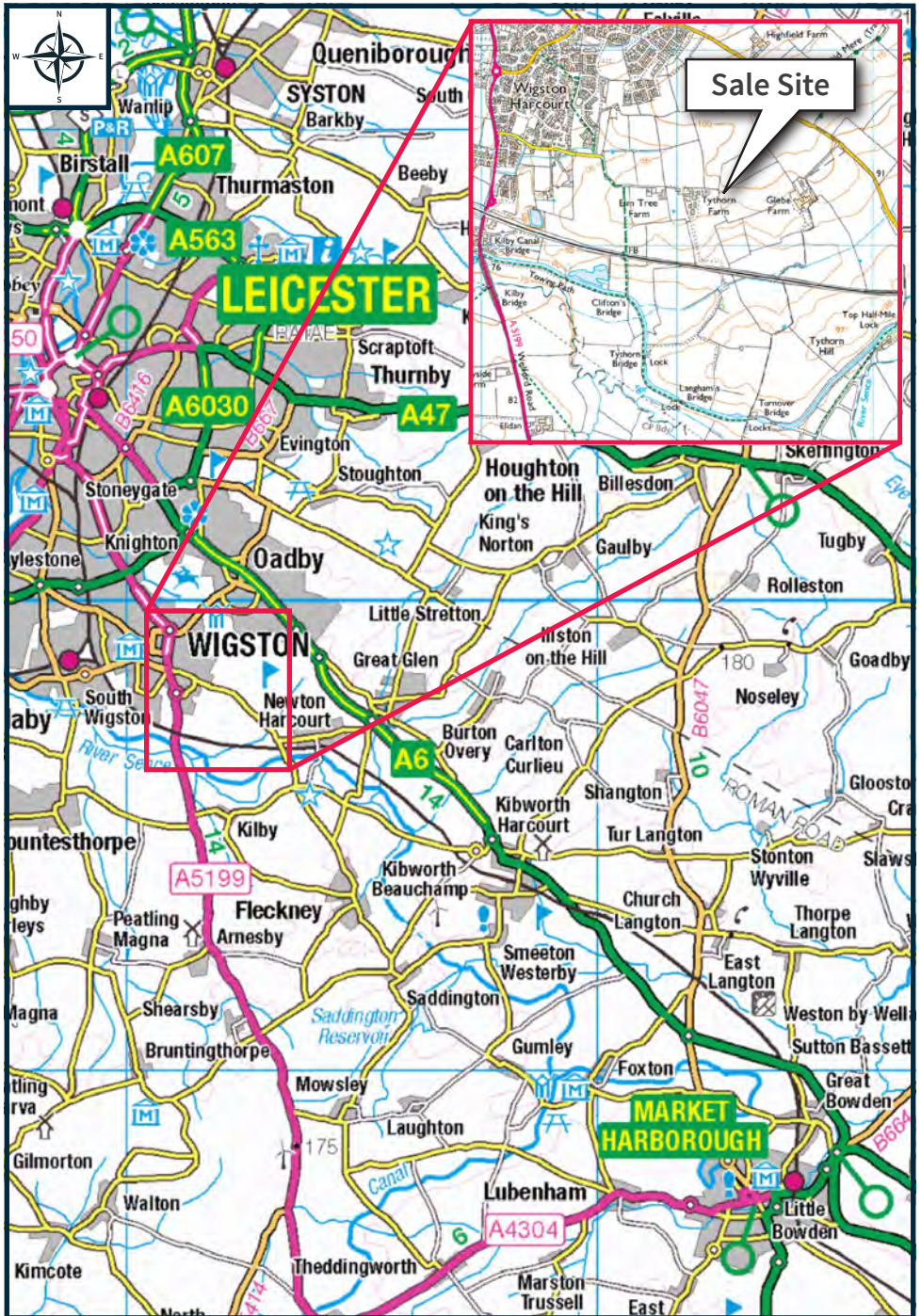

LOCATION

From Leicester city head south taking the Welford Road / A5199 to Wigston. In Wigston at the roundabout take the second exit onto Bull Head Street and continue to follow A5199 for approximately 1 mile. At the next roundabout, take the second exit onto Welford Road / A5199. After 0.2 miles turn left onto Cooks Lane. Follow Cooks Lane until the end and the sale ground will be in front of you.

If approaching from Market Harborough head North-West on the A6 towards 'The Langtons'. After 3.5 miles at the roundabout take the 2nd exit, continuing on the A6 towards Leicester. After 3.7 miles at the roundabout take the 2nd exit onto Station Road and then turn right onto Newton Lane / Glen Road after 200yards. Follow the road for a further mile and then turn right. Follow the road for a further mile and turn left onto Guthlaxton Way. Follow the road for approximately 0.4miles take the 1st exit at the roundabout onto the Welford Road / A5199. After 0.2 miles turn left onto Cooks Lane. Follow Cooks Lane until the end and the sale ground will be in front of you.
