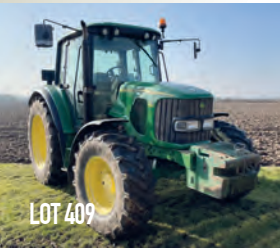

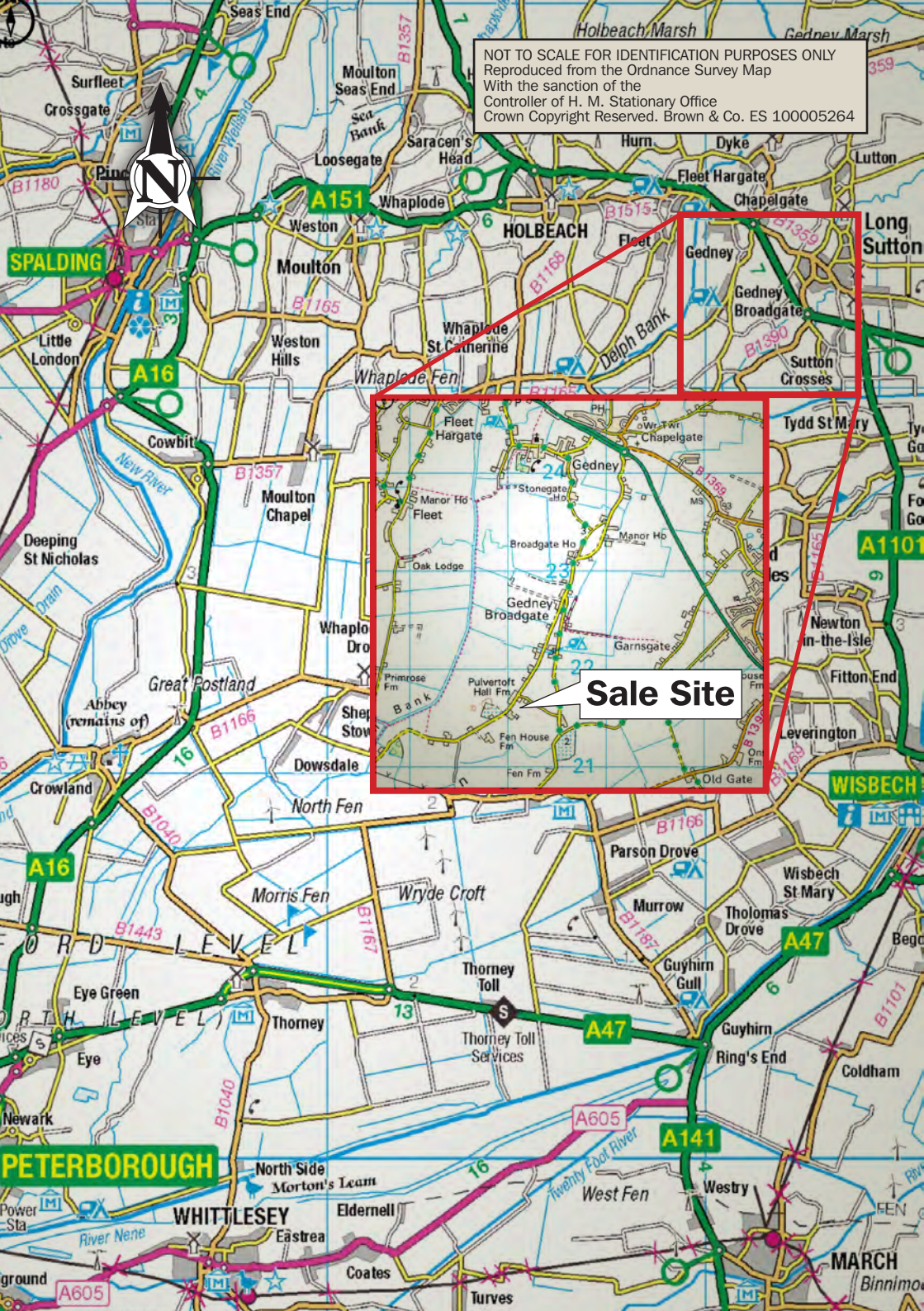

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PURCHASERS PLEASE NOTE:

LOCATION – From Spalding head east on the A151 and follow for approximately 7 miles, continuing to take the 2nd exit at the three mini-roundabouts. On approaching the Peppermint roundabout take the 2nd exit onto the A17. Continue for approximately 0.4 miles and take the 2nd exit at the roundabout continuing along the A17 for a further 4 miles. On approaching the next roundabout take the 4th exit onto Station Road (signposted Gedney Broadgate / Holbeach St Johns). Continue onto Broadgate for approximately 1 mile. Turn left onto Huntsgate then right onto Cade Drove and the sale field will be on the left.

Approaching from Kings Lynn and Sutton Bridge head west on the A17. Continue along the A17 past Long Sutton and at the roundabout for Gedney Broadgate, Gedney Drove End and Long Sutton, take the first exit towards Gedney Broadgate onto Station Road. Continue onto Broadgate for approximately 1 mile. Turn left onto Huntsgate then right onto Cade Drove and the sale field will be on the left.

1 DEFINITIONS

23 SEVERANCE

(i) If any provision or part-provision of these Conditions is or becomes invalid, illegal or unenforceable, it shall be deemed modified to the minimum extent necessary to make it valid, legal and enforceable. If that modification is not possible, the relevant provision or part-provision shall be deemed deleted. Any modification to, or deletion of, a provision or part-provision under this clause shall not affect the validity and enforceability of the rest of the Conditions.

(ii) If any provision or part-provision of the Conditions is invalid, illegal or unenforceable, the parties shall negotiate in good faith to amend that provision so that, as amended, it is legal, valid and enforceable, and, to the greatest extent possible, achieves the intended commercial result of the original provision.
